East Limestone Athletic Association Meeting

Meeting called to order by Earl Glaze.

Financial Report provided by Kim Tucker. The Report detailed income and expenses from opening balance on 11/23/04 of \$4,317.21 to current balance on 8/6/06 of \$25,030.73 and only 1 outstanding check of around \$9 for the financial report copies. Financial statement was approved unanimously.

Old Business

Pat Sheehan discussed the completed baseball season and tournaments. There was several county championship teams represented from East Limestone.

Brad Turner discussed the completed softball season. There was also several county championship teams represented from East Limestone.

New Business

Chad Tribble brought up for discussion and a motion was made by James Partridge to: put new fence and backstop up on field 3 and lengthening it to 190' and having the outfield fence 8'. The current fence would be moved to Creekside for use and going with the bid received for \$11,984(which was the lowest bid). The motion was seconded by Terry Brown. The motion was passed by majority (10 for and 3 opposed).

The Horse Fun Show cleared \$3,763.

Motion was made by Jim Green for earmarking this \$3,763 for getting water at Creekside fields. The motion was seconded by Pat Sheehan. The motion failed with a majority against (6 for and 8 opposed).

Motion was made by James Partridge to spend up to \$5,000 for the use of getting water at Creekside for the fields and potable. This would include having a well dug and having a residential city line run as well (pending approval of school board). The motion was seconded by Brad Turner. The motion was unanimously accepted.
